Volunteers quickly work to prepare everything for their guests, getting ready for the quarterly Foot Clinic at True Worth Place. Stations are set up with a chair, a tub of warm, sudsy water, files and buffers, lotions, and towels. Guests wait patiently to have a little bit of TLC put toward their feet and to receive any necessary medical attention their feet may need.

"This all started back in 2018; I was new faculty at TCU Nursing," says Dr. Kim Posey, Director of Graduate Nursing at TCU, "I knew that we had a lot of involvement, TCU in general, here at True Worth Place. They had shared with me that one of their visions was a foot clinic [....] I felt very passionate and energized at the thought of it; of doing something, you know, so personal and loving as touching the feet, washing the feet, and, again, that symbolism of this is what Jesus did – does! – and this is how we show compassion for our community and the people we love who we want to lift up."

The clinic is staffed by dedicated volunteers, who wash, massage, and buff the guests' feet. After finishing that part of the service, guest move to another section of chairs where they are seen by student nurses, who clip their nails and address any medical issues pertaining to their feet that may need attention.

"I don't usually pamper myself a lot," says Janet, "but when there is an opportunity to come out and get a free service to have whatever needs to be looked at – especially your feet! When you're on them all day long walking out here trying to get food or whatever you need to get, it's wonderful!"

Both the volunteers and the student nurses intentionally engage with the guests as they provide the service, providing a moment of true human

connection.

"Many of them may be embarrassed at first...but then once we start talking to them, they relax and they are so grateful for the help," Dr. Posey continues, "But too, they are just grateful for that friend to listen. They tell you their story and they've got somebody that is non-judgmental just to listen and hear them. And they want to be heard."
